We are seeking a highly skilled individual with strong analytical and documenting capabilities to document key discussions, insights, and outcomes of the summit.

Key Responsibilities:

- 1. Compilation, editing and finalizing the vaccine related concept notes for the summit.
- Accurately document the discussions and synthesize the consensus statement during the summit sessions.
- **3.** Prepare a comprehensive, well-structured final report reflecting the key outcomes and recommendations.
- **4.** Ensure timely submission of draft and final reports as per the agreed timelines.
- **5.** Preparation of a manuscript of the country experience in conducting the National Immunization Summit to be published in a peer-reviewed indexed journal.
